



Travel Through Time Brochure **Publisher Project**

The *Travel Through Time Brochure* project is a desktop publishing project to help you learn the fundamentals of the Microsoft Publisher software. As we move through the tools of Publisher, you and your partner will work for the *Travel Through Time* travel agency and create a fun travel brochure to another time chosen from the list provided.

Requirements:

1. You must first choose a time from the following list: Ancient Rome, Middle Ages, 1400s, Colonial Times, 1920s, 1940s, 1960s, 1970s, 2250
2. The Travel Through Time Worksheet is due on Thursday, January 21st. It is worth 24 points and must be easy to read and filled in completely. This is where you will do your research on your vacation destination. All research and facts must have a documented source meaning the website or source where you found the information.
3. Your travel brochure should include fun facts such as: sites to see, what to wear, food, entertainment, important words/language to know, souvenirs, transportation, and create a special event for the traveler and a minimum of four (4) pictures.
4. Text is to be written clearly with no spelling errors.
5. Fonts must be easy to read and sizes appropriate for headings and text.
6. The backgrounds and color choices must enhance readability.
7. Each group will present their travel brochure to the class. The presentation is to be 3 – 6 minutes in length. Use a presentation software such as Microsoft PowerPoint to enhance your presentation. Add additional information as you speak to enhance your presentation. If you would like to bring in other visuals or aids for your presentation, you may do so as long as they are related and appropriate for school.
8. Keep eye contact with the class and speak clearly and loud enough for all to hear.
9. Project must be turned in on time. See time table below for progress due dates.
